SPECIAL MEASURES

- Increased fumigation & sanitation practices
- Utilizing assigned seating to limit contact and improve contact tracing
- Reduced socializing as much as possible maintaining 3 feet social distancing
- Reduced cross-pollination activities outside of the classroom
 - This includes chapel/devotion, lunch, & CVEL
- We are asking students and staff to wear a mask at all times in the building.
- Special attention is given to ensuring students wash hands properly & use provided hand sanitizer
- NOTE: If there is a medical reason for a child's or staff's inability to wear a
 mask, parents will need to provide us written documentation from your
 medical provider. In the event of a life-threatening situation and a medical
 excuse, a child can attend VCA without a mask
- Limiting visitors (individuals must make appointment to enter building)

EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS

If your child experiences flu-like symptoms or possible COVID-19

Symptoms, please stay home and contact your healthcare provider.

Each day you delay could make your illness worse. If your child develops symptoms consistent with COVID-19:

- Consider getting your child tested.
- Continue to keep your child home from school and avoid other activities around other people.
- Notify the school immediately.

SYMPTOMS OF COVID

- Cough (new onset or worsening of chronic cough)
- Shortness of breath
- Fever
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell

Thank you for keeping your child home from school to ensure the health of others.

IF CHILD TESTS POSITIVE

- The student is removed from class
- Contact tracing will be conducted
- We then advise the parents of the close contact of this exposure
- You reserve the right to have your child tested
 - Please keep in mind, it can take 3-5 days after exposure to test positive
- VCA cannot divulge the child's name that tested positive
- In many cases, the class can remain open if it's an isolated incident
- In some isolated instances, if a class has been compromised, the class may go virtual for quarantining time period
- Looking into providing testing kits to staff and parents who give permission to test their child
- If a student is suspected of flu-like or COVID symptoms, the teacher will call parents to notify them
- Please remain discreet and respectful to each student and family's privacy by not unnecessarily disclosing any positive cases

MAKE-UP WORK

- If your child tests positive for COVID-19 and stays home, that child and any quarantining siblings will be given online work to complete from their teachers
- If your child has flu-like symptoms but has NOT been tested for COVID-19 and you want to keep them home, please call the school office to excuse their absence
 - The normal sick policy would be followed and the student would be required to complete make-up work upon returning to school
 - It is the student's responsibility to make up any missed work
